



Arts Award adviser person specification

Arts Award advisers will, most importantly, have the ability to communicate well with young people.

They should also be able to:

- ▶ create a warm, safe, welcoming environment for young people
- ▶ develop positive relationships with young people
- ▶ generate opportunities for young people to explore their creativity
- ▶ offer young people relevant support and information
- ▶ communicate on a one to one basis and in a group setting
- ▶ offer good interpersonal and organisational skills
- ▶ have relevant experience **and/or** qualifications

Minimum experience required

You must be at least 18 years of age and

- ▶ Have 3 years experience working with young people on a part time basis or 2 years experience working with young people on a full time basis.

Or

- ▶ Teachers may offer their teaching qualification or diploma
- ▶ Lecturers and trainers will commonly hold the City and Guilds 730 level 3 adult trainer award
- ▶ Youth workers will hold NVQ level 3 in youth work

In order to promote good practice and in recognition that Arts Award advisers may work in 1:1 settings with young people, we ask that advisers ensure they have a current CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) enhanced disclosure.
